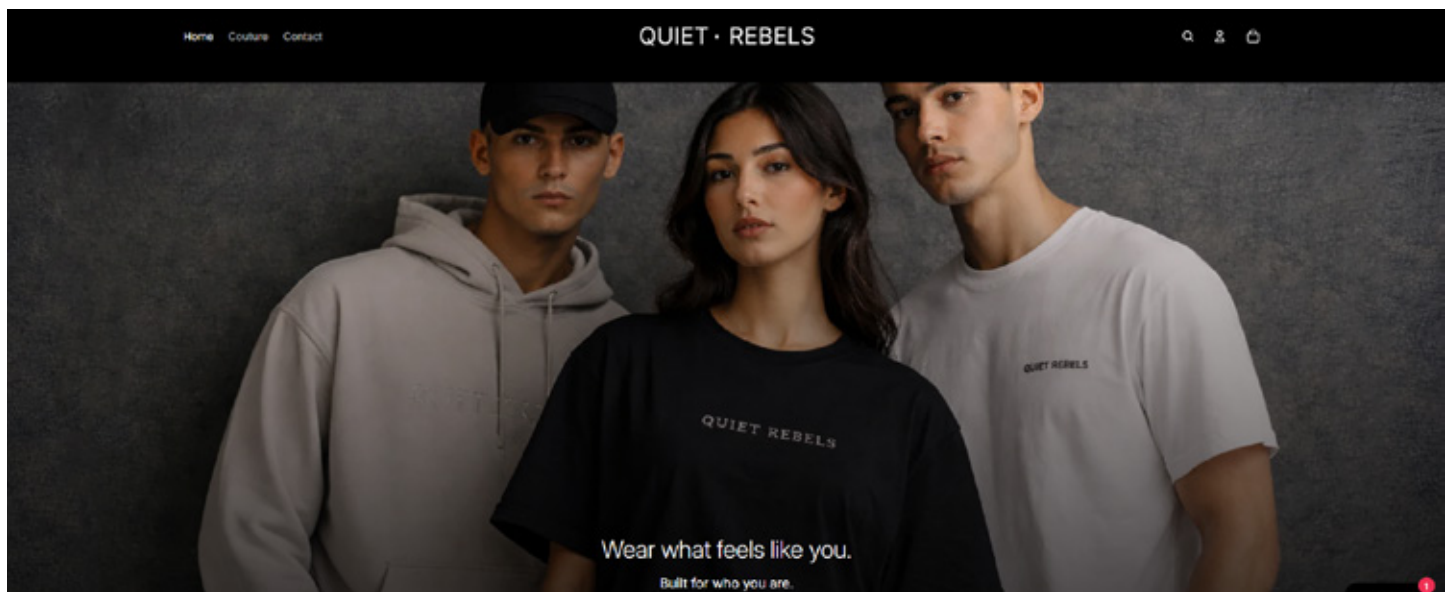
Alumni Growth Circle
