## Inspiring Future Leaders Through Strong Professional Networks

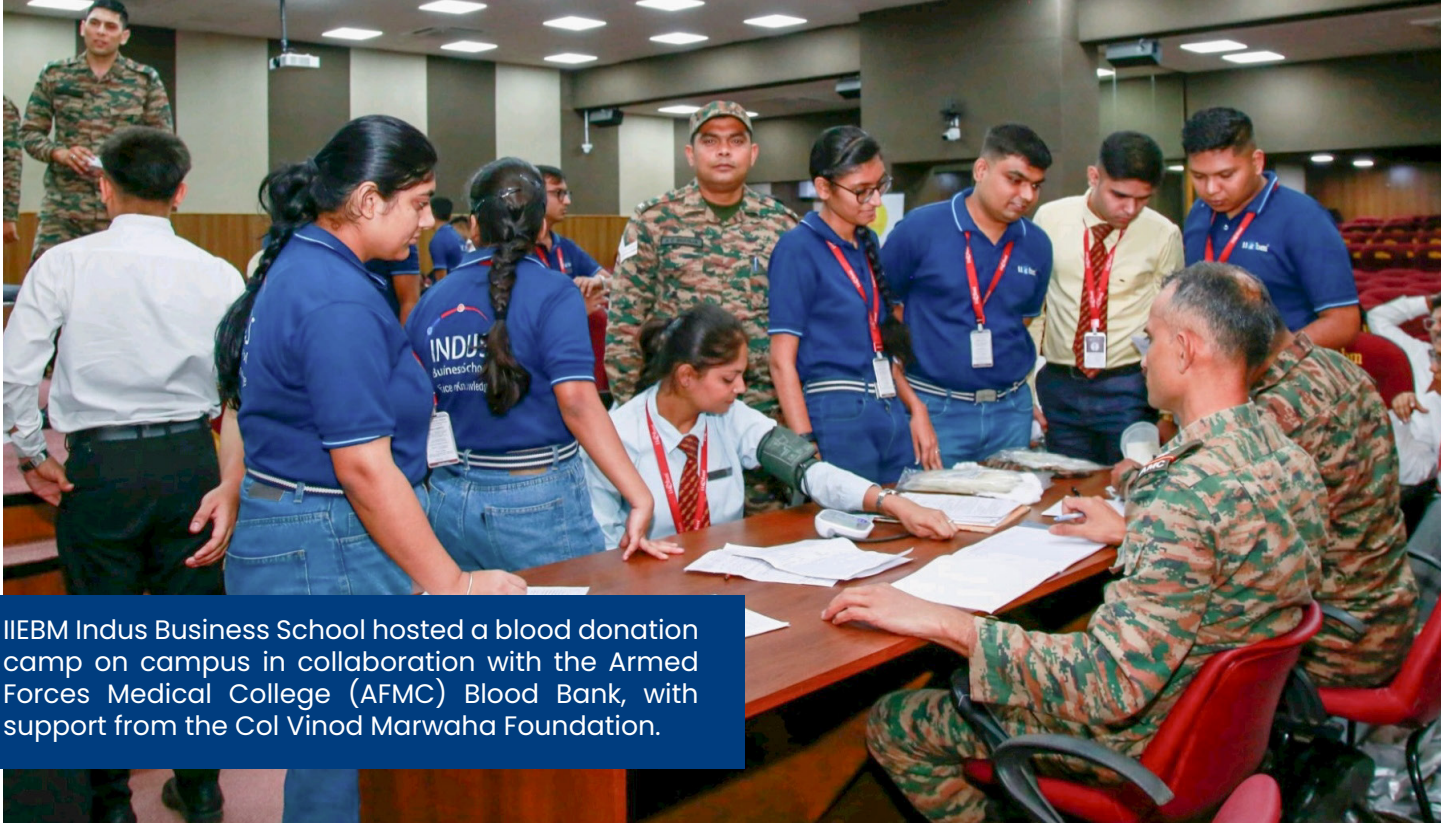
